- A Special Constable is an attested volunteer police officer.

Recruitment Process

















- Minimum Age 18 (no max age)
- Have resided in the UK for 5 years
- Physically fit & able to reach level 5.4 on bleep test.
- 6/12 in either eye & 6/6 binocularly
- Good standard of basic English and Maths
- Clean criminal and financial records.
- Current Occupation is not a conflict of Interest
